Pelé: Así Luce En La Actualidad La Humilde Casa Donde Nació Y Creció El Fallecido Exfutbolist

Pelé, quien nació en la recámara de sus padres, vivió parte de su infancia en una muy sencilla casa, la cual fue demolida hace 50 años, pero su legado sigue vivo.

El 29 de diciembre se convirtió en uno de los días más tristes en la historia del futbol mundial, al darse a conocer la muerte de Pelé, considerado, por muchos, como el mejor jugador de todos los tiempos. Falleció a los 82 años de edad.

Edson Arantes do Nascimento nació el 23 de octubre de 1940 en la recámara de sus padres, ubicada en una casa del municipio de Três Corações, en el estado de Minas Gerais, Brasil. Era hijo de María Celeste Arantes y João Ramos do Nascimento, quienes hicieron un gran esfuerzo por sacar a su familia adelante.

Durante sus primeros años de vida, O Rei, como era comúnmente conocido, no dedicaba su tiempo libre a jugar con otros niños de su edad, sino que lo utilizaba para ayudar con los ingresos familiares, al haber trabajado limpiando botas y hasta en una fábrica de zapatos.

Esos primeros años los vivió en una sencilla casa de un piso, construida en el año de 1910 y demolida en la década de los 70. A pesar de que de su casa de infancia solo quedan recuerdos, en el 2012 una réplica de aquella humilde morada fue reconstruida y así es como hoy en día luce en la calle que fue rebautizaao, como no podía ser de otra forma, con el nombre de Rua Edson Arantes do Nascimento (Pelé).

La casa actual, que buscó revivir la infancia del gran Pelé, cuenta con una pequeña zona de vestíbulo, con cocina, con comedor y con dos recámaras. Una de las habitaciones incluye una réplica de la cuna donde Pelé durmió durante sus primeros años de vida. Al exterior está la zona de patio, que era el sitio favorito del exfutbolista.

A lo largo de la casa hay fotografías de él y de su familia, mientras que en la zona de fachada hay un lienzo de él en compañía de sus padres y de sus dos hermanos, Zoca y María Lucía.

En las cercanías de la casa se ubica el Estadio Elias Arbex, hogar del Clube Atlético Tricordiano, anteriormente conocido como Atlético de Três Corações, club donde militó su padre.

La casa está abierta al público, por lo que, quien así lo desee, puede conocer el lugar que vio nacer al máximo ídolo del futbol brasileño.


- I. How can I serve God in new ways in 2023?

- 6. Am I allowing God to help me and guide me in every area of my life?





I wish you the best as you step into the New Year 2023!









Senator-Elect Eric Lucero (R) Makes Political History in Minnesota

State Sen.-elect Eric Lucero, R-Saint Michael, will be the first Latino American Republican to serve in the Minnesota State Senate. This piece of political history is not new to Lucero. In 2014 he became the first Latino American Republican to be elected to the Minnesota House of Representatives. Lucero lives in Dayton, MN with his wife Erum. He has been one of the rising stars in the Republican party and his colorful and effective social media outreach is known throughout the state. Lucero is a member of the Hispanic Republican Assembly of MN (HRAMN) and has been a keynote speaker at many of the organization's events over the years.

"We are very proud of Eric and we know he will be an effective addition to the State Senate" stated HRAMN Chair Rick Aguilar. Lucero recently announced his new Committee Assignments which include serving on the Senate Education Finance Committee and the Republican Lead on the Senate Housing Committee in the upcoming 2023-2024 legislative session. "Both Housing and Education are high priorities for the community I represent and for all Minnesotans" Lucero stated. In November, 2022 Lucero was elected the State Senator in the newly redrawn Senate District 30 which includes the communities of Rockford Township, Hanover, Saint Michael, Albertville, Otsego, Elk River, Nowthen and western Oak Grove.

Five Tips To Get Outdoors This Winter

Wondering how to get outside and enjoy the outdoors this winter? The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources has some great no- and low-cost activities open to everyone.

"We know Minnesotans love being outdoors, and winter offers a whole different way to play outside," said Ann Pierce, DNR parks and trails director.

The DNR offers several suggestions to make getting outdoors easy and fun for Minnesotans:

GET A VEHICLE PERMIT

- Vehicle permits are required to visit state parks and recreation areas. The cost is \$7 per day or \$35 for an annual permit. Permits can be purchased at a park office or online at mndnr.gov/ParkPermit.
- The DNR also offers free park permits through its library program. More than 100 libraries across Minnesota have seven-day permits that people can check out. Visit mndnr.gov/LibraryPass to see if your library is participating.

LOOK INTO FAMILY-FRIENDLY EVENTS

- Events and programs are scheduled at state parks throughout the winter season, offering a wide range of activities, including escape rooms, interpretive hikes, crafting, education about park wildlife, and more.
- "Whether you want to learn, or be physically active, or both, you're sure to find an event that fits you," Pierce said. "State parks and trails events are suitable for beginners and all age groups."
- State park events are free, but a vehicle permit is required to enter the park. Find state park events on the DNR events calendar (mndnr.gov/PTCalendar).

RENT SNOWSHOES


- Snowshoe rentals are available at 30 state parks and recreation areas, including Fort Snelling and Afton state parks in the Twin Cities metro area. The cost is \$6 per day.
- "Snowshoeing is a great way to be active while beating cabin fever," Pierce said. For snowshoe rental information, visit mndnr.gov/state_parks/snowshoeing.

TRY ICE FISHING

- It's free to fish in many Minnesota state parks; no fishing license required.
- "Ice fishing is a quintessential winter activity in Minnesota," said Pierce. "If you're new to ice fishing, don't worry, we can help. State parks offer events and hands-on learning programs to teach you how to ice fish."
- Read tips, learn about ice safety and find a lake to fish on with the state parks ice fishing guide (mndnr.gov/state_parks/ice_fishing.html).

TRY WINTER CAMPING OR A COZY CABIN STAY

- Winter camping is offered at 25 state parks and recreation areas. For visitors looking for a warmer overnight stay, many state parks offer heated camper cabins with electricity and yurts with wood stoves that are open year-round. Camper cabins accommodate up to six people, while yurts hold three to seven people. Pets are not allowed inside camper cabins or yurts.
- Find the winter camping guide (mndnr.gov/State_Parks/Winter_Camping) on the DNR website, as well as information on staying in camper cabins (mndnr.gov/CamperCabins) or yurts (mndnr.gov/Yurts).
